Montenegro is Open to Business Opportunities with Malta

A strong business contingent accompanied the President of Malta, H.E. Dr Marie Louise Coleiro Preca during a State Visit to Montenegro. The Maltese entrepreneurs benefitted from a high level of exposure to top Montenegrin companies that attended a "Malta - Montenegro Business Forum" that was held at the Montenegro Chamber of Economy on 8th June.

This Business Forum was organised and co-ordinated by The Malta Chamber of Commerce, Enterprise and Industry and the European Enterprise Network (EEN). The 20 Maltese companies forming part of the delegation came from the Construction and Real Estate sector, Tourism, Alternative Energy and Business Materials sectors.

The Forum was attended by H.E. The President of Montenegro Filip Vujanovic, The President of Malta and Officials from both Countries, including the Minister for Foreign Affairs Hon. Dr George Vella and Hon. Minister of Environment, Sustainable Energy and Climate Change Dr Jose' Herrera and other senior officials.

The Forum was addressed by the President of the Montenegro Chamber of Economy Dr Velimir Mjuskovic, The Vice President of the Malta Chamber, Mr Tonio Casapinta and the President of the Malta Developers Association, Mr Sandro Chetcuti. The Forum proceeded with presentations by Dr Gavin Gulia, Chairman of the Malta Tourism Authority with the concluding speeches made by the Presidents of both countries.

Over seventy B2B meetings followed, during the networking session, with the Maltese companies continuing their follow-up contacts the following day.
