New Logistics Business Section within the Malta Chamber established

Election for Executive Committee held on Tuesday

A new business section dedicated to the growing sector of Logistics was set up within the Malta Chamber of Commerce, with the election for the executive committee taking place on Tuesday 23rd August.

With the setting up of this Business Section, the Malta Chamber is once again being proactive in representing a previously underserved sector, in terms of giving it a unified voice to propose ideas and solutions for structured growth.

The five-member committee is composed of Mr. Robert C Aquilina (Salvo Grima Group) as Chairman, Mr. David Fleri Soler (Express Trailers Ltd) as Deputy Chairman, and Mr. Hugh Arrigo (Attard & Co Industrial Ltd), Mr. Pierre Attard (CMA CGM Malta Agency Ltd) and Mr. Ronald Attard (EY) as members.
