

2024 Pre-Budget Document Proposals by

The Malta Chamber of Commerce, Enterprise and Industry on:

RETAIL

- 1. Implement measures to encourage retailers to **transition to e-invoicing** and promote the adoption of **non-cash electronic payment methods** that can be integrated with the electronic systems of other countries. Simultaneously, address the issue of **E-Receipts**, which currently necessitates retailers to provide both a conventional paper receipt and an electronic receipt. Additionally, ensure that **digital signatures** are recognised and accepted by Law Courts.
- 2. Labour costs compensation for business disruptions caused by major public projects which are not completed within the original mandated timeframe compensation would be based on the number of days post the original mandated timeframe.
- 3. Implement Budget 2023 proposal that extends and increases the rent subsidy whereby businesses can receive a maximum annual assistance of €50,000 for the initial 3 years, with proviso of extending period to 6 years, an increase from the previous amount of €25,000¹.
- 4. **Refrain from increasing excise duties,** which is an added cost to industry, amplifying the inflationary pricing pressures faced by producers and importers. In turn, this will circumvent the unavoidable partial increase onto retail and consumers.
